c Telephone poll conducted by GfK NOP for the National Assembly Commission. Number of respondents = 2538. Question asked: "If there were to be a referendum tomorrow on giving the National Assembly for Wales full law-making powers (similar to those held by the Scottish Parliament) how would you vote?"

d Telephone poll conducted by GfK NOP, as part of work to support the All Wales Convention. Number of respondents = 1650. Question asked: "If there were to be a referendum tomorrow on giving the National Assembly for Wales full law-making powers in these areas [specified in previous questions], how would you vote?"

e Telephone poll conducted by ICM for BBC Wales. Number of respondents = 1000. Question asked: “If there were to be a referendum on turning the National Assembly for Wales into a full law making Welsh Parliament, how would you vote?”

f Internet poll conducted by YouGov for Institute of Welsh Politics, Aberystwyth University and Wales Governance Centre, Cardiff University. Number of respondents = 1023. Question asked: “If there were to be a referendum tomorrow on giving the National Assembly for Wales full law-making powers how would you vote?”

g Telephone poll conducted by GfK NOP, as part of work to support the All Wales Convention. Number of respondents = 1553. Question asked: “If there were to be a referendum tomorrow on giving the National Assembly for Wales full law-making powers in these areas [specified in previous questions], how would you vote?”

x. Internet poll conducted by YouGov for ITV-Wales. Number of respondents = 1113. Question asked: “And in this referendum on giving the National Assembly for Wales increased law-making powers how will you vote?”. (NB. Results for this poll, unlike in YouGov polls prior to 2011, were weighted by likelihood to vote).

y. Internet poll conducted by YouGov for the Welsh Referendum Study (first week of rolling pre-referendum wave). Number of respondents = 634. Question asked: “And in this referendum on giving the National Assembly for Wales increased law-making powers how will you vote?” Results weighted by likelihood to vote.

z. Internet poll conducted by YouGov for the Welsh Referendum Study (second week of rolling pre-referendum wave). Number of respondents = 727. Question asked: “And in this referendum on giving the National Assembly for Wales increased law-making powers how will you vote?” Results weighted by likelihood to vote.

A. Internet poll conducted by YouGov for the Welsh Referendum Study (third week of rolling pre-referendum wave). Number of respondents = 694. Question asked: “And in this referendum on giving the National Assembly for Wales increased law-making powers how will you vote?” Results weighted by likelihood to vote.

B. Internet poll conducted by YouGov for ITV-Wales (for use in S4C programme Y Byd ar Bedwar.) Number of respondents = 1003. Question asked: “And in this referendum on giving the National Assembly for Wales increased law-making powers how will you vote?”. Results weighted by likelihood to vote.

C. Telephone poll conducted by RMG for Media Wales. Number of respondents = 1000. Question asked: “Do you intend to vote Yes or No? [following previous question “Do you intend to vote in the upcoming referendum for further lawmaking powers for the National Assembly?”].

D. Internet poll conducted by YouGov for ITV-Wales. Number of respondents = 1036. Question asked: “And in this referendum on giving the National Assembly for Wales increased law-making powers how will you vote?”. (Results weighted by likelihood to vote).

E. Telephone poll conducted by ICM for BBC Cymru-Wales. Number of respondents = 1003. Question asked not stated.
